## SECURITIES FRAUD ALLEGED AGAINST BOISE BUSINESSMAN Refunds Sought In Cell Phone Investment Scheme

Boise, Idaho . . . Gavin Gee, Director of the Idaho Department of Finance, announced the filing of a civil lawsuit against Steven Wayne Olson and his company Salt Lake City Wireless, LLC. Olson and his company operated from Boise, Idaho. The case was filed in the Fourth Judicial District in Ada County.

The lawsuit alleges that the defendants offered and sold securities in the form of membership interests in Salt Lake City Wireless, the securities were not registered in Idaho and the defendants were not licensed to sell securities in Idaho. The Department's complaint also alleged that misrepresentations and omissions were made in connection with the securities offering and sale. Among the misrepresentations and omissions are:

- a) representing to at least one investor that he could anticipate a return on investment of 460% without a reasonable basis for such a claim,
- b) representing to one investor that their investment proceeds would be used for the purchase and operation of cell phone stores in Salt Lake City, Utah, when in fact, Olson used a significant portion of the investor's proceeds for personal expenses,
- c) failing to inform investors of prior state and federal tax liens that had been filed against him,

d) failing to disclose to investors that a portion of their investment monies would be used for

Olson's personal expenses, including trips to Las Vegas and Reno, Nevada, the purchase of

vehicles and other personal expenses, and

e) failing to disclose the results of his prior business dealings and the risks associated with

an investment in Salt Lake City Wireless, LLC.

The Department's lawsuit seeks a court order awarding restitution to the victims in the

amount of \$75,000.00, a civil penalty of \$10,000.00 per violation and attorney fees of \$5,000.00.

The complaint also asks for a permanent injunction against further violations of the Idaho Securities

Act.

The Idaho Department of Finance cautions Idaho residents to make sure that the investments
