His Excellency M. Alexander,
Governor of the State of Idaho,
Boise, Idaho.

Sir: As provided by law, I beg to submit herewith the Thirteenth Annual Report of the State Banking Department covering the year 1917.

As the banking institutions are considered the business barometer, the general prosperity of the State is thereby clearly seen in the remarkable increase of the deposits and loans of all State Banks during the past year, as well as the high average of reserve maintained by these banks, all of which are clearly set out in the various schedules and statements contained in this report. We say remarkable considering the various unusual conditions that have existed throughout the United States during the past year.

During the fiscal year the banks under the supervision of this Department have gained in deposits in round numbers ten millions of dollars, and within this period we have had two Liberty Loan drives in which the State has far exceeded its quota. In each case the State Banks have put forth a remarkable effort on the sale of these bonds, not only in devoting a large part of their time, but in giving their financial support to the fullest extent. The reserve of all State Banks reporting for call of November 20, 1917, shows an average of 30% which indicates that our banks are in a strong position to take care of the emergency needs for financing the different interests of our State.

On June 21, 1917, Congress amended the Federal Reserve Act making it, in our judgment, very attractive for the State Banks and Trust Companies to become members of the Federal Reserve System, not only because the banks would derive a direct financial advantage, but also we feel it is their patriotic duty to our Government at this time to aid in mobilizing all the country's financial resources. Following out our conviction in this matter, we have urged all the banks under the jurisdiction of this Department to become members of the

Federal Reserve System, and at this time we are pleased to state that two of the State Banks, the Genesee Exchange Bank of Genesee, Idaho, and the Bank of Kimberly, Kimberly, Idaho, have been admitted to full membership. At the present time, we have several applications for membership and there are also a number of banks increasing their capital to the required amount in order to become members. With the establishment of a Branch Bank at Salt Lake City, we feel confident that a large percentage of our State Banks and Trust Companies will avail themselves of this added inducement to become members.

Five call reports of condition of State Banks were made during the year on the dates named by the Comptroller of the Currency for reports of National Banks, as follows: March 5, May 1, June 20, September 11 and November 20th.

This report further covers the following schedules:

1st: Comparative statements.

2nd: Receipts and expenditures for the year and biennial appropriation.

3rd: Banks chartered, nationalized, increasing capital stock.

4th: An abstract of condition of banks under the supervision of this Department, 121 State Banks, 12 Bank & Trust Companies, 3 Private Banks, 1 Savings Bank, making a total of 137 as shown by call report under date of November 20, 1917.

In closing, we are pleased to state to you that we have had no bank failures and we are glad to commend the managing officers and directors of our banks for their efficient management and co-operation with this Department.
